## **ORDER**

### **for the amendment of Order No. ПД-01-126 of 09.03.2022**

Pursuant to Art. 61, para. 2, Art. 63, para. 4, 5 and 11 and Art. 63c of the Health Act, Art. 73 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, and in connection with Regulation (EU) 2021/953 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14 June 2021, on a framework for the issuance, verification and adoption of interoperable vaccination against COVID-9 certificates (EU Digital COVID Certificate) in order to facilitate free movement during the COVID-19 pandemic, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/2288 of 21 December 2021 amending the Annex to Regulation (EU) 2021/953 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the period of acceptance of vaccination certificates issued in Digital COVID format EU, stating that the main vaccination series has been completed, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/256 of 22 February 2022 amending Regulation (EU) 2021/953 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the issue of recovery from sickness certificates based on rapid antigen tests, Decision No. 826 of the Council of Ministers of 25 November 2021 on the extension of the emergency epidemic situation announced by Decision No. 325 of the Council of Ministers of 14 May 2020, extended by Decision No. 378 of the Council of Ministers of 12 June 2020, Decision No. 418 of The Council of Ministers of 25 June 2020, Decision No. 482 of the Council of Ministers of 15 July 2020, Decision No. 525 of the Council of Ministers of 30 July 2020, Decision No. 609 of the Council of Ministers of 28 August 2020, Decision No. 673 of the Council of Ministers of 25 September 2020, Decision No. 855 of the Council of Ministers of 25 November 2020, Decision No. 72 of the Council of Ministers of 26 January 2021, Decision No. 395 of the Council of Ministers of 28 April 2020

**ORDER :**

1. In point I, 4.4. of Order No. ПД-01-126 of 09.03.2022, after the words "such a document" is added "are examined, if possible, by the border health control authorities with a rapid antigen test or".

2. The order ought to be published on the website of the Ministry of Health.

The order is subject to appeal within one month from the publication on the website of the Ministry of Health, in front the relevant administrative court under the Administrative Procedure Code.
